Friday May 28th 10.30-4.00 Latvian Mitts £70

Every Latvian mitten has its own story, and every pattern knitted has its own meaning and brings with it its own wish. Most patterns have been derived from the Latvian traditions of deities and gods. Every deity and god had its own tasks and mission and it was represented by one or more symbols that characterised it.

In this workshop we'll look at some of these traditional symbols and incorporate them into out own knitted mitts.

Saturday May 29th(filling fast) Textile Taxidermy £80

join us at the studio and create a unique wall decoration for your home. We will be using Abraham Moons' woven fabrics and a variety of threads to produce a stag, hare, elephant, cheetah, monkey, bear.....whatever you fancy!

Sunday May 30th Learn to knit socks! £70

Knitted socks! In this workshop you'll learn: stretchy rib, turn a heel and graft/ mattress stitch. You will knit a mini sock, knit a few more for practice and homework, then graduate to knit yourself a pair

Sunday June 6th Steeking £70

Steeking allows a piece to be knitted in the round even when openings (such as cardigan fronts, armholes, or necklines) are necessary. This is especially helpful for stranded colorwork knitting, as it avoids the need to purl back while stranding, making your work much easier and your tension more even.
